

Joseph R. Benedetto Scholarship

Description

The Joseph R. Benedetto Scholarship is intended to support those engaged in or planning to work in the engineering/manufacturing fields. **A student** registered in a full time course related to engineering or manufacturing, or any group which supports students in STEM in Canada, is eligible to apply. Candidates can reside anywhere in Canada but the educational institution they attend should be in Ontario. At the Scholarship Committee's recommendation exceptions may be made. **A group** can be a school-age group supported by a community organization or an educational institution or a student chapter, but must be involved in something related to STEM.

This scholarship was founded by Toronto Chapter 26 in the mid 1990s and created to acknowledge the significant contribution to the Chapter by Joseph R. Benedetto, (1931-2013), a long time member and past chapter chair.

A maximum of three scholarships up to a total of \$3000CAN, will be awarded each calendar year. The application deadline is January 15. Results will be announced in May. SME membership is not a requirement as membership in SME is awarded as part of the scholarship.
