To recognize and reward Tomorrow's brightest talent, SME Chapter 57 (Society of Manufacturing Engineers) has created (2) \$1,000 scholarships. These scholarships will be awarded as follows:

(2) \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who has taken Manufacturing and/or Engineering courses at an accredited institution in the Kansas City area. See the online scholarship application for the awarding preferences.

The scholarships will be awarded based on a short-written essay, academic performance, and demonstrated potential in a Manufacturing and/or Engineering career field. The scholarships are designed to motivate students to work toward achieving their goals and build awareness of Manufacturing and Engineering fields with unlimited potential as a career path.

A complete scholarship application includes the following information:

1. Please complete and submit the scholarship application – see the link below.
2. Provide an official transcript with your application.
3. Provide at least one (1) letter of recommendation from a high school faculty member. You may also submit up to (2) additional letters of recommendation from SME members and/or other faculty members at your school. The recommendation letter(s) should provide evidence/examples of the applicant's exemplary integrity, ethics, initiative, service to others, and career potential.
4. Scholarship applications and the other required documents must be submitted to the [2022 SME Chapter 57 Scholarship Application](#) by Midnight CDT on November 23, 2022.

The selection of the scholarship recipients will be made by a committee appointed by the SME Chapter 57 Board of Directors. The scholarship winners will be notified via telephone and email by December 2, 2022. The scholarship winners will be invited to attend our annual Scholarship Award Ceremony and Silent Auction, details to be announced later.
